

## Membership General Rules & Regulations

## GENERAL RULES AND REGULATIONS

- 1. It is the intent of *The WildeWood Club* to limit these rules and regulations to the minimum required for the mutual enjoyment of *The WildeWood Club* by all its members and guests. The obligation for enforcing these rules for the good of all is placed in the hands of management. Management reserves the right to alter these rules as necessary.
- 2. Members must conform and adhere to all rules and regulations as set forth by *The WildeWood Club*. Any rules violations can result in potential disciplinary action or revocation of membership.
- 3. **Tee Time Policy:** Members can book a weekday tee time up to 14 days in advance. A tee time for Saturday or Sunday can be booked the Tuesday before by the member. The pro shop will not automatically block tee times. You can book a tee time online, by calling the pro shop, or stopping by the pro shop. Non-members (HOA/TENNIS/SOCIAL Members) may obtain starting times 14 days in advance regardless of weekday/weekend play. Management reserves the right to make special considerations for tournaments, special events and out-of-town guests.
- 4. Practice Facility Rules: Full golf members may have access to the practice facilities year-round. Non-golf members may have access to the practice facilities only before the scheduled tee time DAY OF PLAY.
- 5. The hours of operation will be established considering the season of year.
- 6. Dogs and other pets are not permitted inside the facilities, and must be on a leash in all other situations including the golf course.
- 7. The roster or list of members shall be considered the property of *The WildeWood Club* and shall not be used or given to anyone for any reason whatsoever.
- 8. Firearms and any other weapons are not permitted on the property at any time.
- 9. All annual services are billed on an annual basis and are not prorated. No refunds will be given for partially used periods.
- 10. Each member as a condition of membership and each guest as a condition of invitation to the facilities assume sole responsibility for his or her property.

- 11. The Professional Staff always has full authority of the golf players. They are directed to carry out the rules and regulations pertaining to the golf course and play. Any violations are to be reported to *The WildeWood Club* management.
- 12. No more than four players may play as a group, unless authorized by the Golf Shop.
- 13. No more than two golf carts per foursome and one golf cart per twosome are allowed.
- 14. Each player must have a golf bag and a set of clubs.
- 15. All play must always start on number 1 tee unless permission to do otherwise is obtained from the Golf Shop.
- 16. All players must obtain a starting position from the Golf Shop.
- 17. All faster players to play through if there is an open hole ahead of your group.
- 18. When using power or pull carts and arriving at the green, park cart 20 yards from the green but between the green and the next tee on the cart path. This will allow the following players to play to the green as soon as you complete play at the hole and are off the green.
- 19. Golf Cart Restriction: Golf carts are not allowed to be driven close to the greens. When approaching the green the carts must be parked at least 20 yards away from any part of the green.
- 20. Please repair ball marks on greens, fill divots with sand provided on each golf cart, and rake bunkers. (Leave rakes in bunkers)
- 21. All members and guests are expected to follow *The WildeWood Club* appearance code and adhere to the tradition and respect for the game. Shorts must be appropriate length and all trousers and shorts must have a hem. All men's shirts must have a collar and sleeves (turtlenecks and mocks are acceptable). Ladies' shirts should complement these standards. Denim shorts and t-shirts are not acceptable. This regulation applies to the golf course, practice facility, and clubhouse. Proper attire is required. Shirt and shoes are required at all times. The attire should match the activity you are taking part in at the club. The club manager will monitor and in force a family friendly dress code at their discretion.
- 22. Children under 15 years of age are not allowed on the golf course without adult supervision on Saturdays, Sundays, or Holidays until after 1:00 p.m. unless authorized by the Golf Shop.
- 23. Members must have an established handicap to play in *The WildeWood Club* tournaments. Members desiring to establish a handicap must post all scores after each completed round.
- 24. The Director of Golf Operations has the authority to schedule starting times as circumstances may require.
- 25. The USGA rules of golf shall govern all play.
- 26. The Club membership, where applicable, entitles member/spouse/partner grandchildren and dependent children, thru age 24 or under, to membership privileges.

- 27. The Professional Staff always has full authority of the premises. They are directed to carry out the rules and regulations pertaining to the facility. Any violations are to be reported to *The Wilde Wood Club* management.
- 28. **The WildeWood Club** policy requires a 30-day written notice for all resignations from membership. Neither termination nor resignation of membership cancels an obligation to pay the unpaid balance of the Entrance Fee or monies owed on account.
- 29. Should you resign your membership, you may not rejoin as a member for the next 12 months. You may play at *The WildeWood Club* as a guest of a member at non-member rates during those 12 months if your account balance is paid in full. Should you decide to rejoin after the 12 months, you may do so under the rates and regulations in effect at that time including payment of the initiation fee at that time.
- 30. Our newsletter serves as an official notification of changes in policies and procedures. We encourage members to read it carefully.
- 31. Guest Play: A guest of a member can play a maximum of 2 rounds per month regardless of how many members they play with. The pro shop staff will monitor this closely.

  Guest Play Addendum: Any adult (over the age of 24) living as a household member of a golf member has access to guest play at the club with no guest play restrictions or round limitations per month. The household member of the guest will be charged the current guest rate and will need to prove residency.
- 32. Unaccompanied Guests: If you as a member cannot play with your guest (s) you are allowed to book them as a tee time at the unaccompanied guest rate of \$65 (or rate at the time)
- 33. Cashless Policy: The club has a cashless policy for all pro shop, tennis center, and food & beverage. The only exception is at the pool snack bar. Please member charge or use debit/credit card when making a purchase on club property.
- 34. Range Balls: Range balls are to be used for the driving range only. Any use of range balls on the property is strictly prohibited. Please leave any range balls on the range.

## **SWIMMING POOL**

- 1. The Seasonal Swimming Access is available to HOA, Social, Tennis and Golf Memberships.
- 2. Access includes immediate family consisting of the member's spouse and their unmarried children thru the age of 24.
- 3. The hours of operation will be established considering the season of year.
- 4. All members and guests must register upon entering the Swimming facility.
- 5. All guests must be accompanied by a member.
- 6. Children 12 and under must have adult supervision. Children needing diapers are required to wear swim diapers when swimming in the pool.

As a member, I agree to conform to and be bound by the rules and regulations for use of the WildeWood as a Member. These rules and regulations for Membership Classes may be amended by WildeWood as deemed necessary to provide for the safety and enjoyment of all members.	
11. Pool in	In the event severe weather occurs, all members and guests shall be asked to exit the swimming namediately.
10.	Lifeguards will have 10-minute breaks every hour. At this time all swimmers 18 and under are required to exit the pool. Adults may utilize the pool during this time.
9.	No glass bottles or containers allowed on pool premises.
8.	The swim guest fee is \$5 per person.
7.	Each member will be required to sign in with their membership number before utilizing the pool.
